I was born and raised in Sebastopol, California by a cowboy and cowgirl, on a small family ranch.





- " I learned that I do not like to take out the trash.



Some challenges I had to overcome in my career


- " Being a young woman in business can mean having to work extra hard to prove yourself. Learning to take the high-road and always work with your best self in mind has been invaluable as a result.
