CLEARANCE NOTES:

- 1) Assigned Assists are always cleared with “780”, No RD, Narrative optional.
- 2) You cannot clear a Tag prior to going 10/98 on that Tag.
- 3) Narrative is not Necessary (follow station directions)

SIGN-OFF/SIGN-ON REGARDING VEHICLE EXCHANGE (B/O VEHICLE)

- 1) Request a MODIFY LOG format by typing CHGL and depressing the SEND key.
- 2) After receiving the message prompt, “MODIFY LOG FORM DOWNLOADED”, enter the ending mileage for the exchanged vehicle into the CHGL format and depress the SEND key.
- 3) Request a second MODIFY LOG format and use the SPACE BAR to delete all vehicle related fields (BEGINNING/ENDINGG MILEAGE, VEHICLE #, SP EQUIPMENT and the MOBILE RADIO ID). Then depress the SEND key.
- 4) Perform a SIGN-OFF procedure. Type “OFF” on a blank screen. Depress the SEND Key.
- 5) Perform a SIGN-ON procedure from the new vehicle’s MDT and enter the UNIT, SHIFT, DEPUTY #1, PASSWORD, BEGINNING MILEAGE, VEHICLE NUMBER, SP EQUIPMENT, and MOBILE RADIO ID.
- 6) Perform a WORKSHEET STATUS (WS) to check for uncleared tags. Download all uncleared incidents (tags) from the exchanged MDT by typing in UPD and the tag number (Ex: UPD 182).

NOTES:

- 1) Sign-on must be done from an MDT. Logging-off may be accomplished at a station terminal or at an MDT. Logging-off in either case automatically signs-off the MDT.
- 2) Sign-off may be done at anytime and will not affect the status of a logged-on unit. MDT’s may be signed-on again as long as the unit remains logged-on.
- 3) Any MDT sign-on replaces the last sign-on for that unit.

LOG OFF;

- 1) Select LOG-ON/OFF format and enter necessary information,
- 2) Switch MDT off after logged-off notification is received. Log-Off should include the following information:
Place an “X” in the OFF field, UNIT ID, SHIFT, ENDING MILEAGE, O/T PA (if applicable), O/T #1 and O/T #2 (if applicable), and PATROL AREA/TIME.

END OF SHIFT:

- 1) Ensure that all Calls/Tags are cleared.
- 2) Clear your Message Buffer (CTRL+CLR).
- 3) If necessary, you may Log/Off on Inside Terminal.

RETENTION CODES

"1" indicates a one year retention period and is used for misdemeanors and non-criminal reports.

"2" indicates a two year retention period and is used for Use of Force memos.

"4" indicates a four year retention period and is used for misdemeanor sex, narcotics violations, marijuana cite outs, domestic violence, and felonies not otherwise covered, and injury to county employee.

"5" indicates a five year retention period and is used for stolen or recovered items with serial numbers excluding firearms or boats on trailers.

"6" indicates a six year retention period and is used for stolen or recovered vehicles. (LASD only)

"0" indicates an infinite retention period and is used for sex crimes, homicides, dead bodies, missing persons, missing juveniles until age 18, stolen, lost or found firearms, and offenses where there is no statute of limitation.

JUVENILE LAW DEFINITIONS & GLADYS R. ADMONITION

DEFINITIONS OF TERMS PERTAINING TO JUVENILE LAW:

C.Y.A. - California Youth Authority. A state agency charged with supervising and coordinating the many functions of the state in its dealings with youth in trouble, including operation of state juvenile detention facilities.

DELINQUENT - A person described in Section 602 W.I.C. A juvenile who violates the law.

DEPENDENT – A person described in Section 300 W.I.C. A juvenile who is destitute, from an unfit home, a victim of physical or sexual abuse lacks parental supervision or is physically dangerous to the public or self.

DIVERSION - The alternative handling of selected offenders away from the justice system to community-based organizations as a viable delinquency prevention technique.

D.C.S. - Department of Children's Services. County department charged with the care and housing of dependent juveniles.

INCORRIGIBLE – A juvenile who is beyond the control of his/her parents. One of the persons described in Section 601 W.I.C. A Status Offender.

J.A.J.N. - Juvenile Automated Index Number Probation's Department (LA County only) automated juvenile record system.

JUVENILE - a person under the age of 18.

JUVENILE DELINQUENT - Generally considered to be any juvenile whose anti-social acts come to the attention of any law enforcement agency.

MAJORITY - The status of being of full age (18 years). The age at which a person attains capacity to exercise full civil and personal rights (excluding alcohol).

MINOR – A person who has not reached the age of majority, (18 yrs)

PETITION - The document used to initiate proceedings in Juvenile Court

STATUS OFFENDER - Non-criminal conduct unique to the status of being a minor A person described in Section 601 W.I.C. (i.e. runaway, incorrigible, curfew violator, or habitual truant).

SUBJECT - Term to describe juveniles in official crime reports.

VICTIM - Term used to describe minors in dependency (300 W.I.C..) cases.

WARD OF THE COURT - A person who has been found by the Juvenile Court to fall within the descriptions of Sections 601 or 602 W.I.C.

W.I.C. - California Welfare and Institutions Code

GLADYS R. ADMONITION

This Admonition is to be used for all arrestees under 14 years of age at the time of the crime. It should be given after Miranda rights have been given but waived by the subject. . . Note: Extra care should be taken in advising young subjects of Miranda rights. Determine that the subject knows the meaning of the words lawyer, judge, court, silent, appointed, etc. Indicate these explanations in the subject's waiver.

Questions to ask the Minor:

1. Do you know the difference between doing what is right and what is wrong?
2. Can you give me an example of something that is right to do?
3. Can you give me an example of something that is wrong to do?
4. (A) Do you know that it is wrong to do (SPECIFIC CRIME)?

Note: Write down the simple words you used to describe the specific crime being investigated. (i.e. instead of using the words 'theft or steal'; use 'take something that is not yours without permission; instead of using the word "assault" use "start a fight": etc.)

- (B) If someone did (SPECIFIC CRIME) to you, would you think that it was wrong?
- (C) Were you ever told that it was wrong to do (SPECIFIC CRIME) ... By your parents? At church? At school? By a friend?
- (D) Have you ever been punished for doing (SPECIFIC CRIME)?
- (E) Have you ever heard of someone being arrested or punished for doing (SPECIFIC CRIME)?
5. Did you understand that it was wrong to do (SPECIFIC CRIME) at the time that you did it?
6. Do you go to school? What grade are you in? What school do you go to?

PROBATION VIOLATION REPORTS

 - c) IF BOOKING IS APPROVED, COMPLETE AN ARREST REPORT AND INCLUDE:
 - i) THE FACTS CONCERNING THE VIOLATION.
 - ii) PROBATION STATUS.
 - iii) REASON FOR PROBATION (ORIGINAL CRIME).
 - iv) THE ASSIGNED PROBATION OFFICE AND D.P.O. NUMBER.
 - v) THE COURT WHICH HAS JURISDICTION OVER THE PROBATIONER.
 - d) FORWARD A COPY OF THE ARREST REPORT TO THE APPROPRIATE PROBATION DEPARTMENT AREA OFFICE.
- 3) IF THE JUVENILE IS BOOKED ON A NEW CHARGE, HE OR SHE MAY BE ADD CHARGED WITH A VIOLATION OF PROBATION (777 W.I.C.).
 - a) INCLUDE THE ABOVE INFORMATION IN YOUR ARREST REPORT.
 - b) IF THE JUVENILE IS TO BE HELD AT AN INTAKE DETENTION CENTER (I.D.C.) THE NEW CHARGE IS NOT SUFFICIENT TO DETAIN. THE JUVENILE'S DEPUTY PROBATION OFFICER OR A SUPERVISING DEPUTY PROBATION OFFICER MUST BE CONTACTED TO OBTAIN APPROVAL.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

DEFINITION OF TERMS - 13700 P.C.

“*Abuse*” means intentionally or recklessly causing or attempting to cause bodily injury, or placing another person in reasonable apprehension of imminent serious bodily injury to himself or herself, or another.

“*Domestic Violence*” means abuse committed against an adult or a fully emancipated minor who is a spouse, former spouse, cohabitant, former cohabitant, or person with whom the suspect has had a child or is having or has had a dating or engagement relationship.

“*Dual Arrest*” means the arrest of more than one party involved in an incident of domestic violence.

Note: By law dual arrests are discouraged, but not prohibited. Deputies shall make reasonable efforts to identify and arrest only the primary aggressor. The primary aggressor is defined as the person determined to be the most significant aggressor rather than just the first aggressor.

“*Officer*” means any officer or employee of a local Police Department or Sheriff’s Office, and any peace officer of the CHP, State Police, Department of Parks and Recreation, UCPD, or the Cal State University and College Police Departments.

“*Victim*” means a person who is a victim of domestic violence.

“*Cohabitant*” means two unrelated adult persons living together for a substantial period of time, resulting in some permanency of relationship.

Note: Factors that may determine whether persons are cohabiting include, but are not limited to: Sexual relations between the parties while sharing the same living quarters; Sharing of income or expenses; Joint use or ownership of property; Whether the parties hold themselves out as husband and wife; The continuity of the relationship; and The length of the relationship.

EMERGENCY PROTECTIVE ORDERS (EPO)

A Deputy may obtain EPO’s, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Call (213) 974-1234 and ask for the on-duty Commissioner. EPO’s are valid until 5:00 PM on the 5th court day or 7th calendar day from the date of issuance. EPO’s and restraining orders must be served to be valid and a peace officer may serve them.

Ensure the station secretary enters the service of the order into the Restraining Order System. (The order and the Proof of Service must be attached together.) Violations of EPO’s and Domestic Violence Restraining Orders are arrestable under 273.6 RO., and the violation does not have to occur in the officer’s presence. EPO’s may also be issued in child abuse cases.

There is a difference between 166 P.C., which is a generic section for violation of a court order, 273.6 P.C. that specifically addresses domestic violence and should be used when making arrests for violation of court orders pertaining to domestic violence not committed in the deputy’s presence, and 836(C)(1) PC. which states that grounds for arrest without a warrant on domestic violence calls and the victims right to make a private person’s arrest.

Note: A court order is valid, even if the victim asks the Restrained party to violate the order. Only a judge can change the court order.

OBSERVATIONS & STATEMENTS

It is imperative that Domestic Violence reports accurately describe the scene of the incident. This includes notations of the condition of the abuser, if the abuser is (or is not) under the influence of alcohol or a controlled substance, the number of times (including 0) a law enforcement agency has responded to a domestic violence call at the same address with the same alleged abuser and victim, and statements made by all parties involved.

It is important to include in your report the observations you made when you arrived, including: if the altercations was still in progress, what you heard upon approach, what you had to do to quell the disturbance, and what you saw. Describe in your report the physical appearance of the scene and if it indicated any physical altercation had just occurred, noting any broken items or overturned furniture, etc.
